Some Final Notes:

In addition, we kindly remind everyone to drive slowly and cautiously through the parking lot at all times!

* **Tap Ties** - If your daughter is in our Creative Combo, Kinder Combo or 1st Grade Combo, we'd like to request that you please be sure their tap shoes are tied securely before sending them into the classroom. While we know how much they like to assert their independence, it takes a lot of time away from dance time if the teachers have to continually re-tie or tighten the shoes to ensure safety.
